There are two major ways to move items in Moodle.

Use Drag and Drop to Move Items in Your Course

If Javascript is enabled in your browser, you can drag-and-drop items within the Moodle course page.

1. Step 1:

Click Turn Editing On (top right). Editing icons will appear.

- 1. Step 2: For Activities and Resources:
- 2. Click and drag the **move icon** () for the item you wish to move. As you drag, Moodle will display a shadow of the item in the location it will relocate to if you release the mouse.
- 3. **Note**: If you are using the Collapsed topics format, you cannot move an item into a closed section. First click the **Section name** to open an individual section.

5. For Topic or Weekly Sections:

- The Move icon is located on the left side of each Section. Grab a Section by its Move icon () and drop it on top of another Section to place it above that Section. You cannot move the top (General) section.

8. For Blocks:

9. To move a Block, place the cursor over the block's *Heading*. Depending on your browser, the cursor will change to show a *Hand* () or a *Move* icon (). Drag and drop the block on top of another block to place it above that block.

Click on the Move Item and select the new location

1. Instead, just click on the move icon - usually a cross-hairs icon as (1) below. This then displays a screen where you will see links to all the items on your page and the tops of <u>sections</u> (2). Just click to select the location you want to move your item to and the job is done. No dragging or scrolling.
