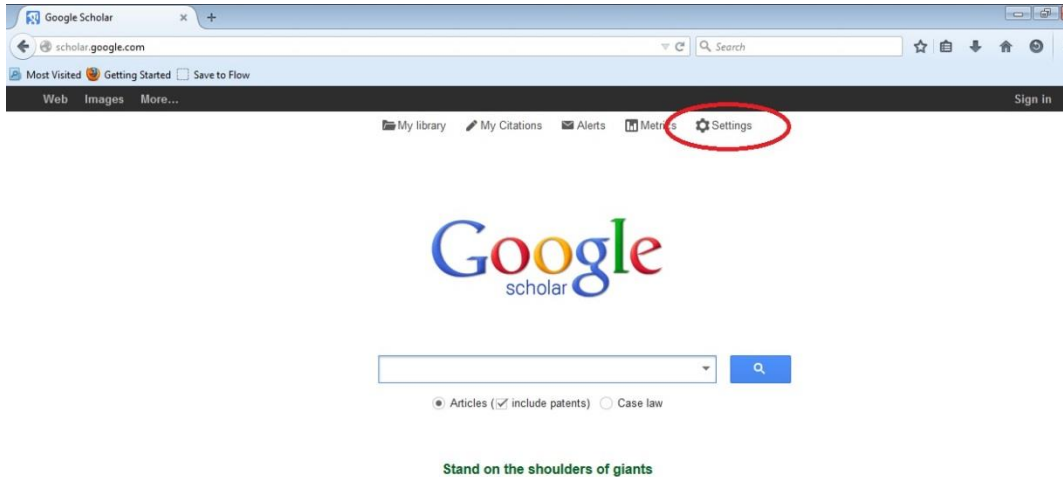


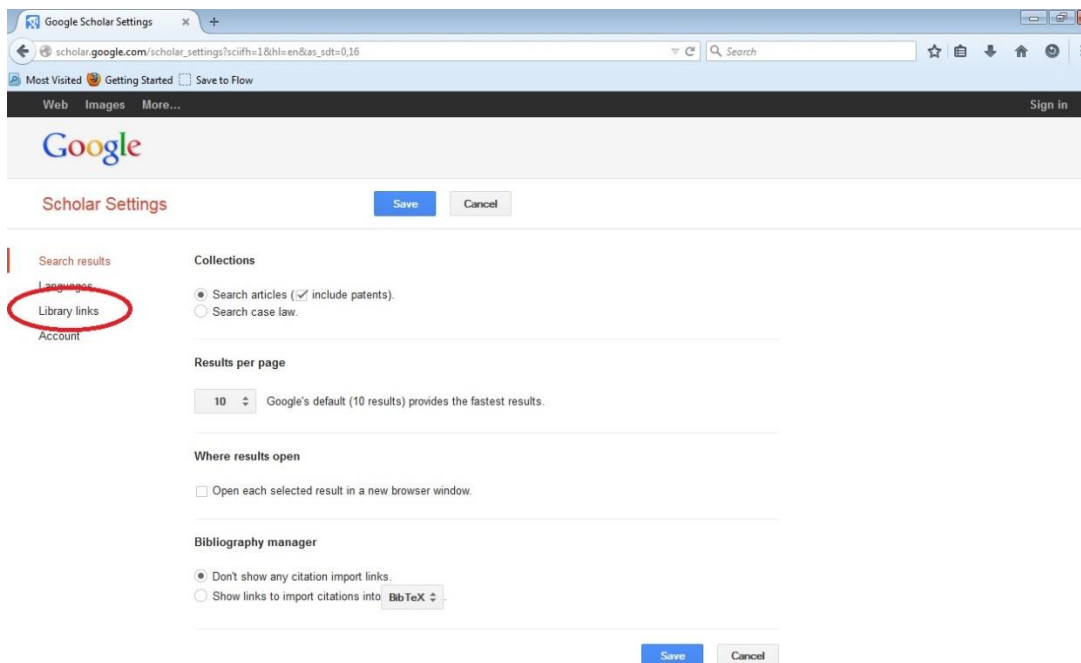
Google Scholar @ Dunn Library – Set Up

[Google Scholar](#) can search Dunn Library's journal collection. To set up Google Scholar to search Dunn Library, use the following steps.

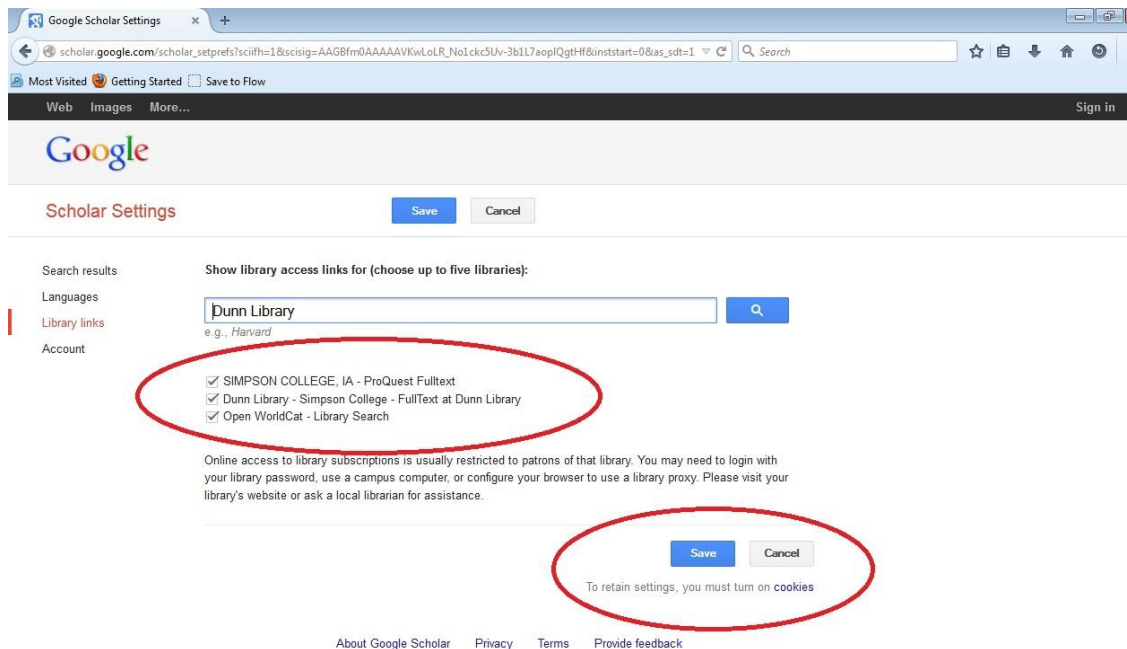
1. Click on settings in the right hand corner.



2. Go to the Library links on the left hand side.



- If the Dunn Library links are not selected, search for Dunn Library in the search box. Select the resources from the search. Click the save button to accept.



- When you do your search in Google Scholar, hotlinks located in the right hand column will say "FullText at Dunn Library". This will link you to the article or an Interlibrary Loan form.

If no "FullText at Dunn Library" is along the right hand side, check under **More** in the citation for "Search Dunn Databases" for additional searching of Dunn Library resources.

Full text from other resources (free or not) may be listed as well in the right hand column.
