

8 QUICK FACTS ABOUT SEXUAL ASSAULT & TITLE IX

- 1** **Title IX prohibits** sex discrimination in education programs that receive federal funding.
- 2** **Sexual harassment**, including sexual assault, is a type of sex discrimination.
- 3** **Sexual assault** = a physical sexual act done **against a person's will**. Including when a person is incapable of giving consent due to drug or alcohol use.
- 4** **One in five women & one in thirty-three men** are victims of completed or attempted sexual assault while in college.
- 5** If Simpson College knows about sexual harassment, including sexual assault, **Title IX requires Simpson to take immediate action**.
- 6** Schools are required to publish **grievance procedures** for those who complain of sex discrimination, including sexual assault.
- 7** If you file a complaint, **regardless of where the assault occurred**, your complaint must be processed.
- 8** Title IX investigations are different from law enforcement investigations. Even if you file a police report, **Simpson College is independently required to investigate the assault**.
