The qualified applicant must possess excellent organizational, written and verbal communications skills. This position will serve as top assistant in the wrestling program. Responsibilities will include assisting with the recruitment and retention of qualified student-athletes, the planning and implementation of practices, scouting, individual coaching sessions, equipment, office work, and other duties as assigned. The applicant will serve as a leader, role model, and mentor to student-athletes and will be upheld to the moral and ethical standards as set forth by the institution.
