

Campus Nurse

The Simpson College office of Student Development invites applications for a part-time nurse to work 15-21 hours per week. This is a 10-month, part-time, one-year position, with the possibility to be renewed. This part-time position will provide nursing assessment and documentation of student health needs; ongoing treatment and referral to medical providers/resources on campus; process, assess, and maintain community health/immunization records and data; and assist in campus-wide health education/promotion efforts. Special emphasis on assisting in campus-wide efforts to manage and respond to COVID-19 pandemic.

Qualifications: At minimum, Registered Nurse with current license in the state of Iowa. Competent knowledge of nursing skills with at least three years of work experience. Up to date with continuing education expectations. Experience with health education on a college campus, general wellness education, public health, or psychiatric nursing preferred. Computer experience Publisher, Excel, and database preferred.

The successful candidate must possess a strong commitment to the development and welfare of students and must have the ability to establish and maintain working relationships with other members of the campus community. The applicant must also possess a positive attitude and a collegial working style, with an ability to work independently while also contributing positively to a team-oriented environment.
