Editing Audio Files

Install the Program

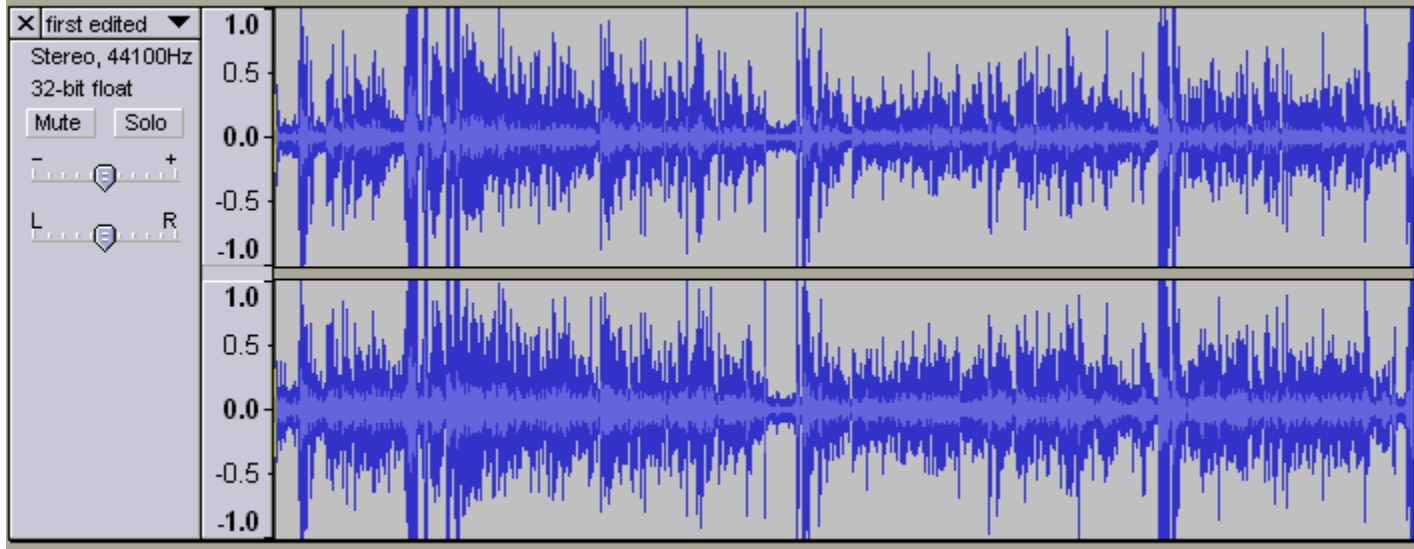
- Install from CD or from <http://audacity.sourceforge.net/download>
- You will also need to download the “LAME MP3 encoder” in order to export files as MP3 files
 - Click on LAME MP3 encoder
 - Read and follow the instructions

Create a New Project

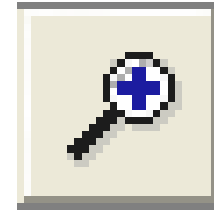
- File

Import Audio

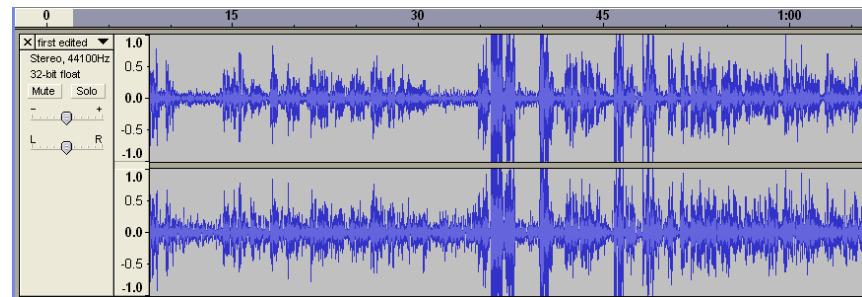
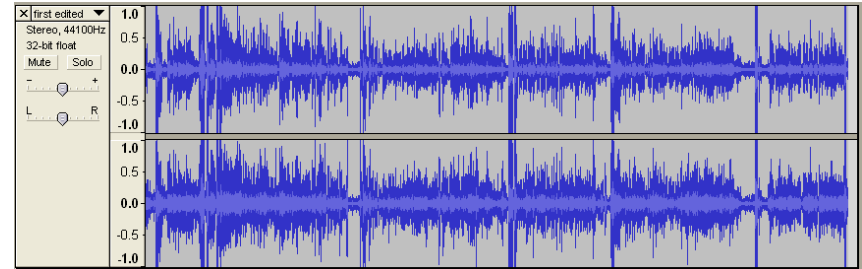
- Project
 - Import Audio
 - Select the file you've copied from the digital recorder



Magnifying Glass



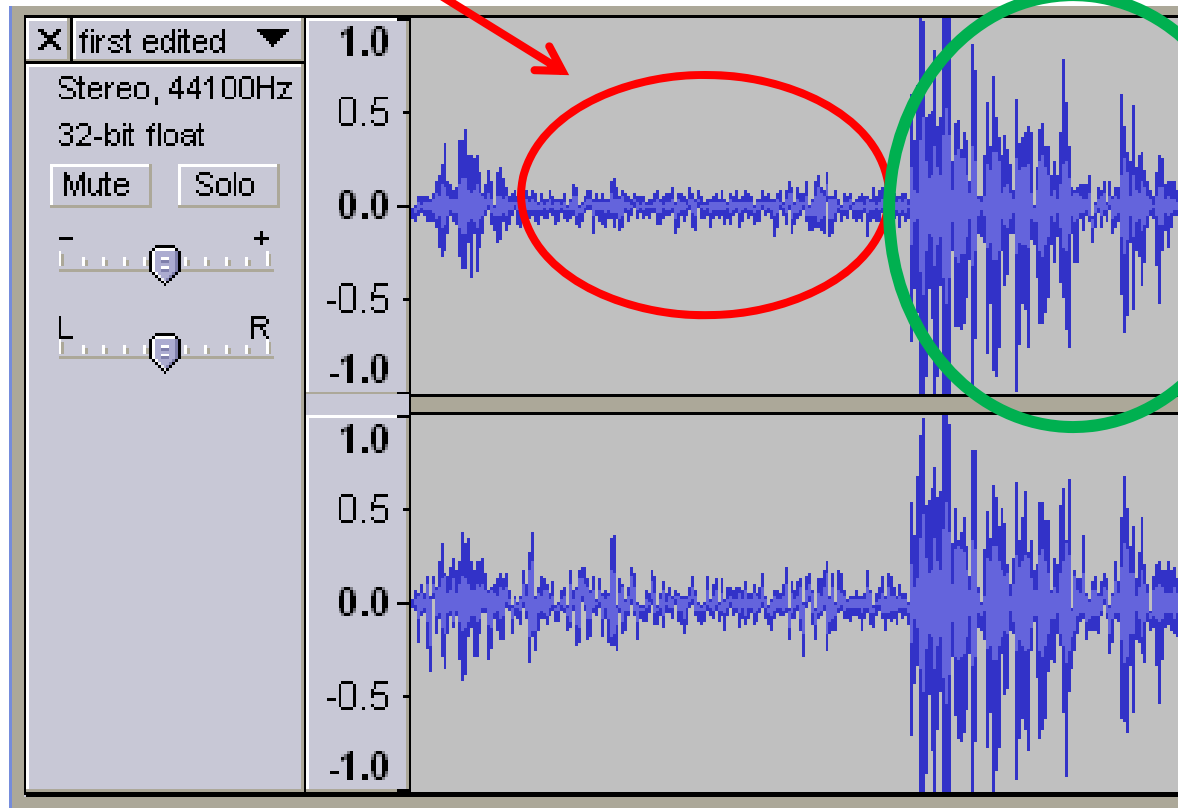
- Audacity will fit the entire audio recording onto the screen
- Click on the magnifying glass to focus in on a shorter time period

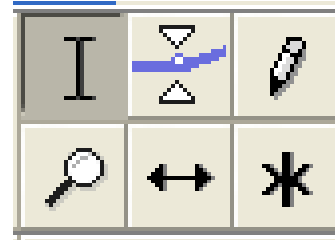

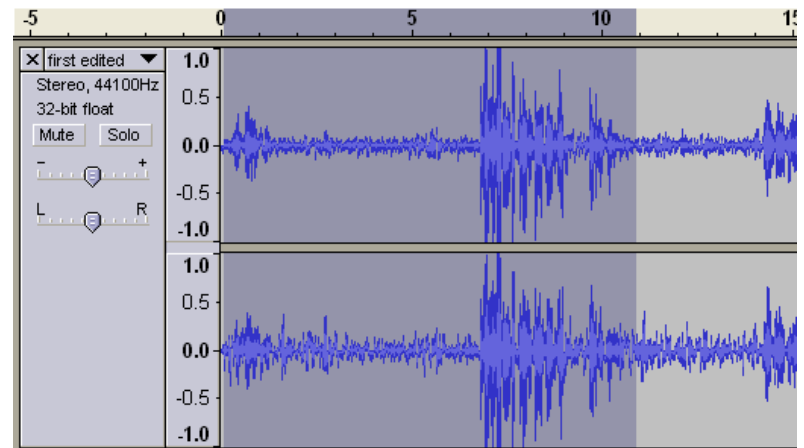


Select Segments and Listen

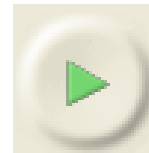
- Click “Select Tool”



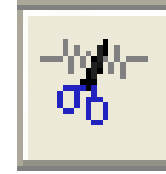
- Select section of track
 - Selected segment will be darker



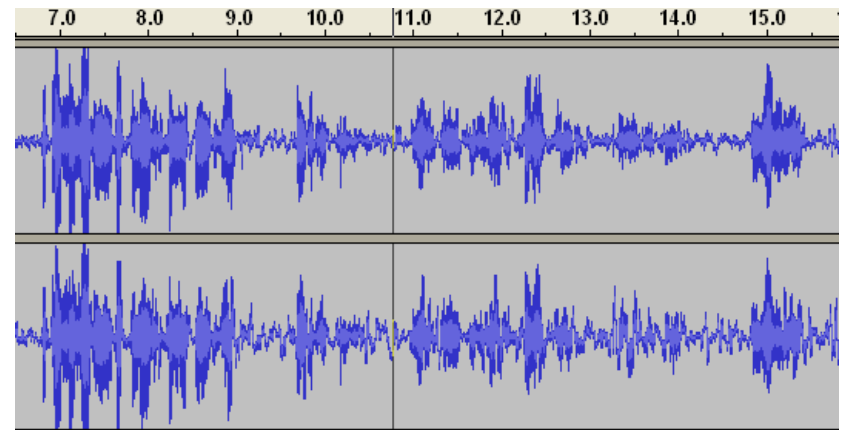
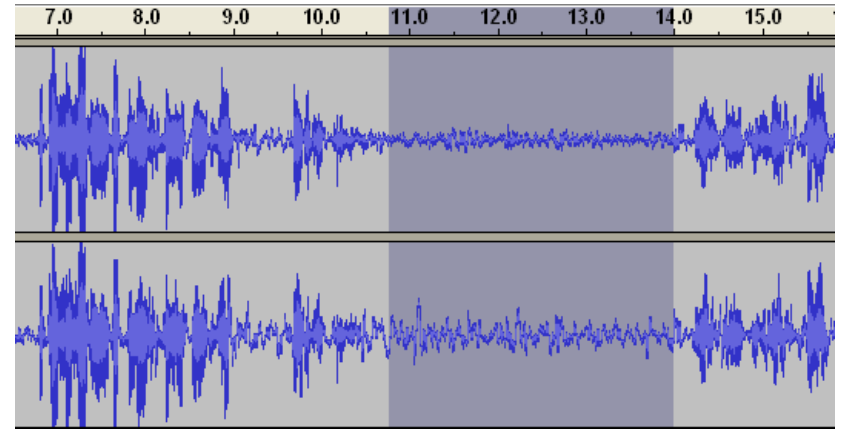
- Click Play



Cutting Segments



- Select
- Listen
- Cut
- Select surrounding segments
- Listen



Noise Removal

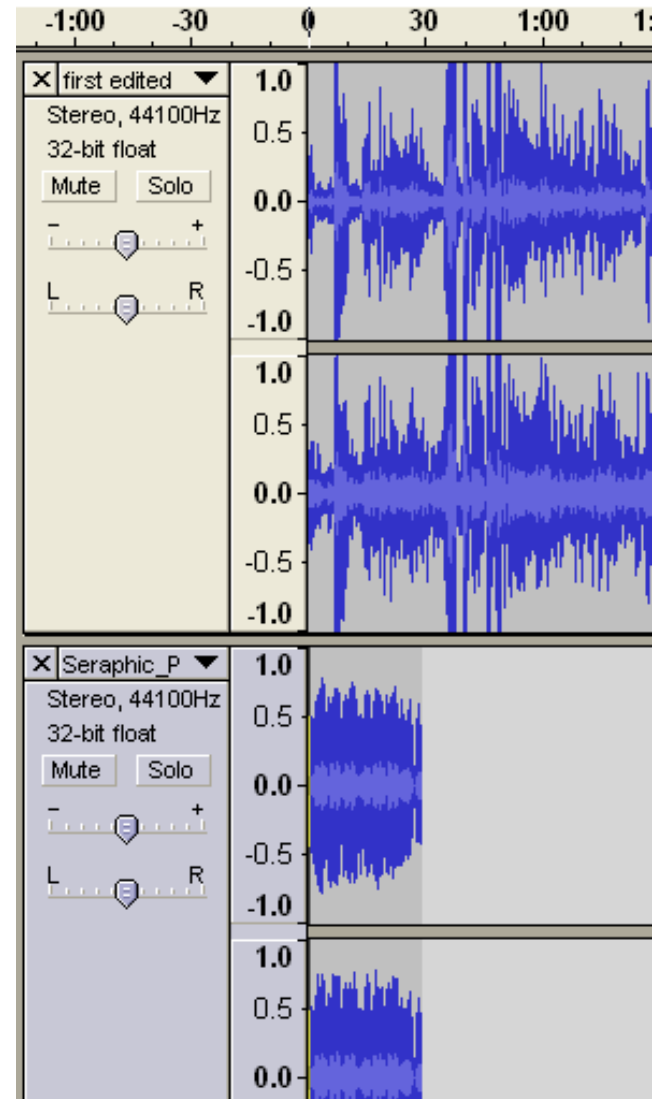
- Select a small piece of audio that is silent except for the noise
- Noise Removal → Get Noise Profile button
- Select all audio you want filtered
- Noise Removal → Remove Noise button
 - Experiment with the Less/More slider
 - More can lead to audio distortion

Other Effects

- **Compressor** - compresses the dynamic range of the selection so that the loud parts are softer while keeping the volume of the soft parts the same
- **Normalize** – allows amplify such that the maximum amplitude is a fixed amount, -3 dB

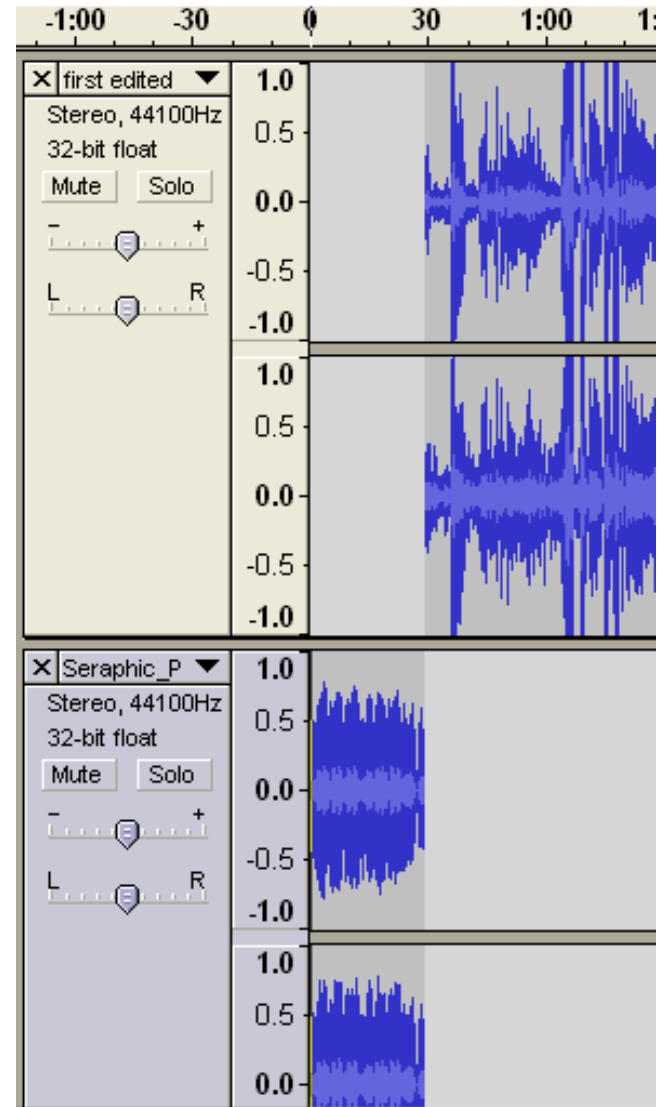
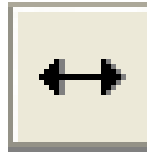
Multiple Tracks: Importing

- Import an audio file containing music
 - <http://podsafeaudio.com>
 - Project: Import Audio...
- The new audio is in a separate track, but at the same time as the first track



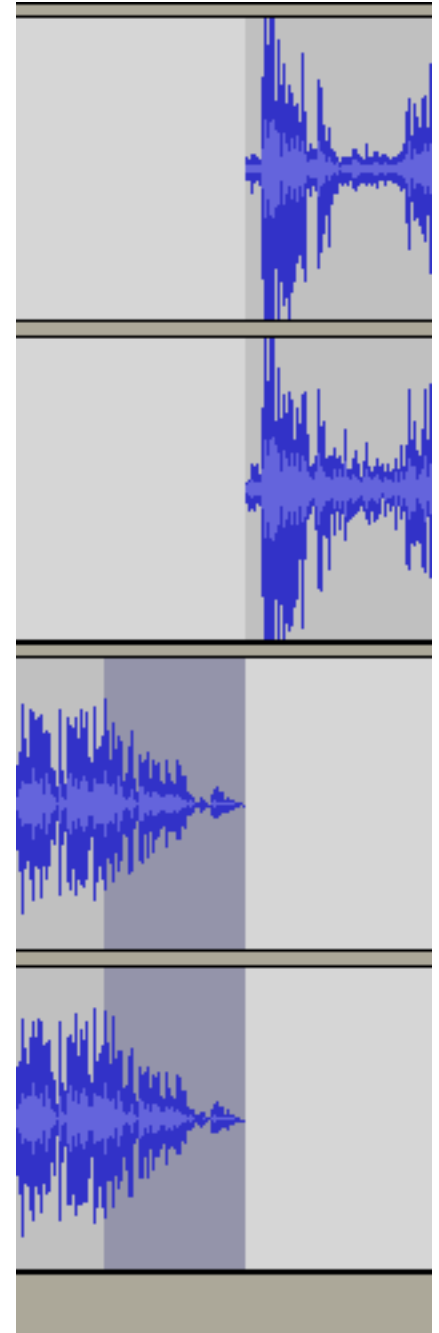
Multiple Tracks: Shifting

- Use the Time Shift Tool to drag one track to the right of the other



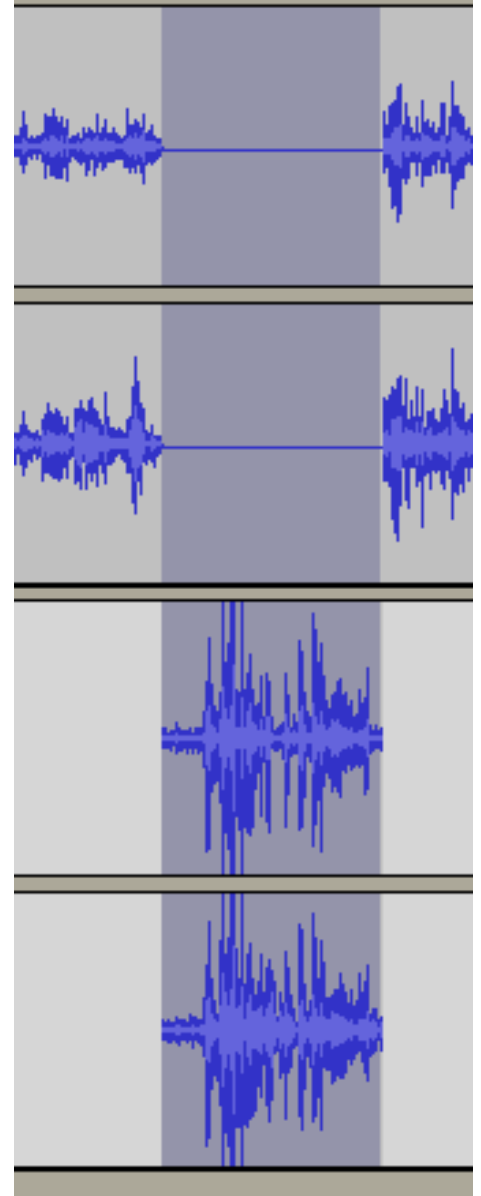
Multiple Tracks: Fade Out

- Select the end of the first segment
- Effect: Fade Out



Multiple Tracks: Split

- Select a segment to move to a second track
- Edit: Split
 - The selected segment will be moved to a new track



Multiple Tracks: Combine

- Combine tracks to reduce the number of tracks on the screen
 - Hold down Shift and click on each track you want to combine
 - Project: Quick Fix
- Tracks will automatically be combined when you Export to MP3
