

## FOUR-YEAR PLAN OF STUDY: GERMAN

**Additional Information:**

The pathways through the German major depend on the student's starting level and the point in the pathway that the student studies abroad. All German majors are required to have at least 8 credits of academic work taught in German in an immersion setting. Below are three typical pathways. More are possible (especially since it is possible to start either in the fall or in the spring from GER 110, or 111).
