Additional Information:

The pathways through the Spanish major depend on the student’s starting level and the point in the pathway that the student studies abroad. All Spanish majors are required to have at least 8 credits of academic work taught in Spanish in an immersion setting. Below are three typical pathways. More are possible (especially since it is possible to start either in the fall or in the spring from SPAN 105, 111, 220 or 222 and that there are alternatives to the semester program in Chile to complete the immersion experience)
