

**SIX-YEAR GRADUATION RATES FOR SIMPSON COLLEGE STUDENTS WHO ENTERED IN THE FALL OF 2013
AND WERE EITHER RECIPIENTS OF A PELL GRANT OR A SUBSIDIZED DIRECT LOAN**

The tables below show the six-year graduation rates of students who entered Simpson College in the fall of 2013 (i.e. the Class of 2017) and were recipients of Federal Pell Grants (table 1) and recipients of Federal Subsidized Direct Loans (table 2).
