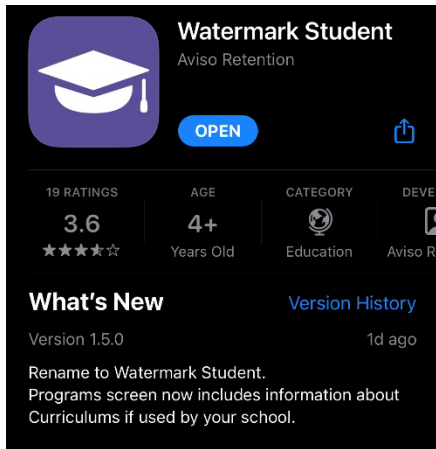

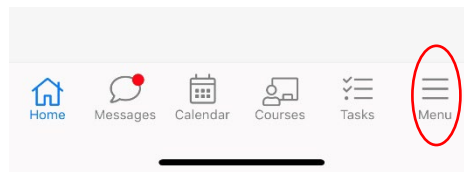

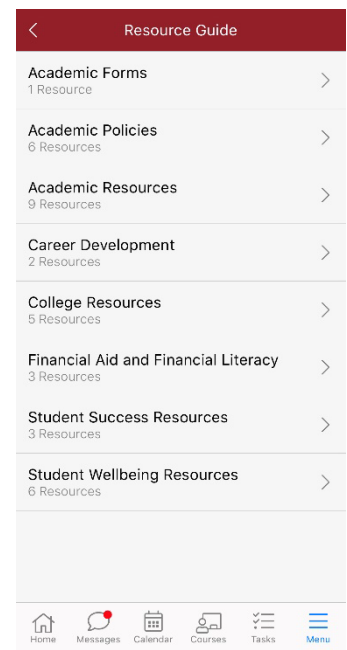
Six navigation tabs are available in the app (located on the bottom of the screen):

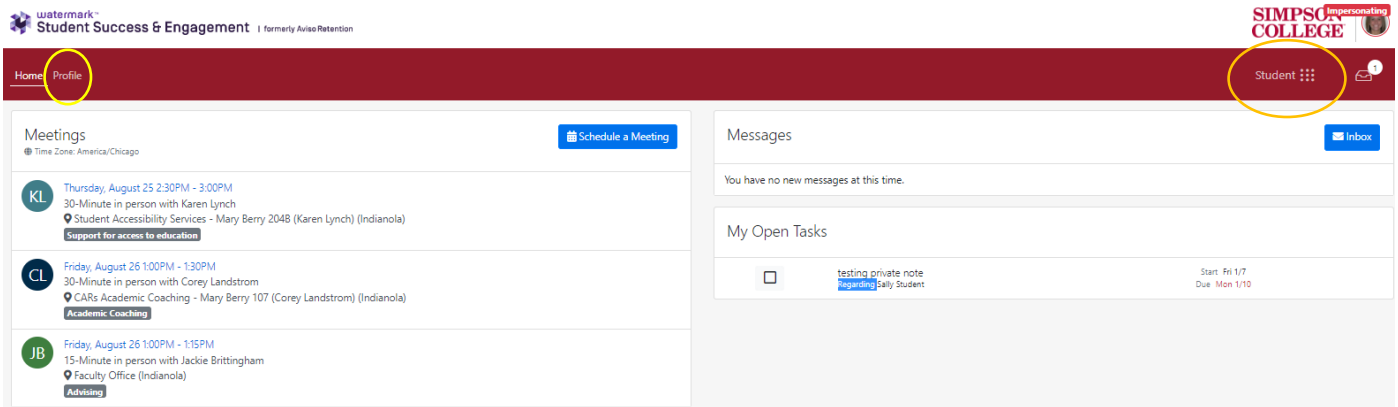

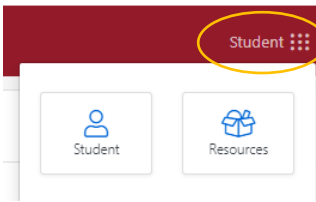

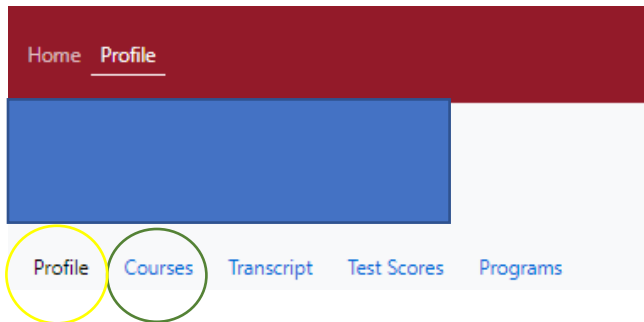


Resources page



You navigate to the Resources page by clicking the Student menu (orange oval) and selecting Resources.

Profile page



By selecting the **Profile** menu (yellow oval in left image), you gain access to your profile information including your student ID number, your email addresses and preferred mailing address, and if on file, a nickname/preferred name. Your advisor(s) will also be listed on this page.

In addition to your profile, you can also access current and past courses you've taken, an unofficial transcript of your courses and earned grades, and your program (majors). For most students, the Test Scores will not include any test information (ACT/SAT).

To access your courses information, select the **Courses** menu (green oval above), toggle to the specific term using the Term pulldown menu. Each term you have been enrolled will be available to view.
