

## **Summer College Mentor Job Description**

#### **Upward Bound Description:**

The program provides opportunities for participants to succeed in their pre-college performance and ultimately in their higher education pursuits. Upward Bound serves high school students from low-income families and/or from families in which neither parent holds a bachelor's degree.

#### **Purpose and Details of Position:**

The College Mentor provides supervision, support, encouragement, and mentoring to participants during the summer Upward Bound program.

Upward Bound programming for Summer 2023 will be delivered via a hybrid model for students entering 9-12 grade. These students will participate in classes both virtually and in-person. Graduated high school seniors will live on campus and enroll in a Simpson course.

Additionally, students will engage in fun, social, in-person activities on the days they are on campus. College Mentors will live on Simpson's campus for the duration of the six-week program.

College Mentors receive a stipend totaling \$2,500.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Actively participate in and successfully complete College Mentor training
- Provide support to instructors during academic classes
- Plan, organize, and carry-out enrichment activities and small group meetings
- Assist Upward Bound staff with carrying out on-campus activities
- Build community amongst participants
- Complete required documentation, including tracking student attendance and participation
- Other duties, as assigned

#### **Job Qualifications:**

- Grade point average of 3.0 or higher
- Experience with high school aged students, preferred
- Previous experience with Upward Bound or other TRIO programs, preferred
- Preference given to candidates who are from low-income and/or first- generation college student
